

SOCIALISM IN REVIEW

What I witnessed in the last election cycle reminded me of a book and its consequences, that I once read when I was about seventeen years old. Then I reread the book and discovered that in today's political and governmental realms these same strategies are being employed, so I've written some notes and will share them with you. I have included a few examples so you can draw your own conclusions.

Does the word 'socialism' have any meaning for you? Webster defines socialism as: "any of various theories of the ownership and operation of the means of production and distribution." It is the step between capitalism and communism.

Through 'National Socialism', the government becomes the ultimate controller; this actually occurred between 1919 and 1945. Socialism is being taught in today's schools, being read in the daily fish wrappers, (newspapers) and watched on the tube and even heard on certain government run radio stations with a lot of government propaganda - some in the form of radio ads. National Socialism is the tool Adolf Hitler used to come to power in Germany during World War II.

What needs to happen to transform a basic 'capitalist society' into a 'sold soul', if you will? I have compiled a short list of incidentals and personalities needed to bring socialism to pass.

INCIDENTALS

1. Economic confusion or creation of economic instability
2. The complete control of print and news media; including radio and internet
3. The implanted ideology in government; that a certain leadership and personalities are the infallible solution
4. Convince the industrialists or those who have free market abilities of future prosperity, in ideals and gather those individuals who have a lust for power around you; these individuals will be in the background. They will be led to accept by force of government to submit their will and profit to the state
5. Peace for safety has to be engaged for a successful withdrawal of all human resistance or spirit to resist; a complete crushing of human dignity. How do you do that?
6. Create the impression that those who do not agree with you are a deterrent to the true goals and prosperity of the nation. To gain complete control of the educational system in this system you can have no moral absolutes; no definition of right or wrong

Some examples

- Teach that life has no value, (via abortion)
- Teach the examples you want to be followed: environmental communism
- You are the world; the world is you

- Humanism: lead the youth to believe that the state is the only prevalent force to make the right decisions
- Make guilt a role model to be used; for control
- Teach believable lies:
 - ✚ global warming, for instance
 - ✚ and life doesn't begin at conception
- Restrict parental authority; for the state always knows best

7. Symbols are to be employed to create a new unity in the direction of your complete combination for your ideals and territorial conquests; most of all, your complete domination of a once free people. In the case of National Socialism it was the swastika.

8. No one you are associated with is to be reproached for any reason as long as they serve your purpose. To quote Hitler - he said, "I know Esser is a scoundrel, but I shall hold on to him as long as he is of use to me." This was his attitude toward almost all of his collaborators, no matter how murky their past or indeed their present. Murderers, pimps, homosexual perverts, drug addicts, or just plain rowdies were all the same to him if they served his purposes.

9. What was the voting factor? A measure of Control, you must have "boots on the ground." Hitler had the S.D. which eventually became the S.S. and the S.A. These bodies of men became the physical backbone to the power of the movement. They were the ones who took to the streets to do the bidding of their master. They got out the vote and made sure the right person was elected. This branch must look like a political force rather than a military one.

SUMMARY; THE ACTS OF A TRUE SOCIALIST

When elected, you must seize power, make proclamations and demonstrate your strength. All opposition must be done away with. Seize - to bring about your total end, compassion for the weak and sick are only a tool, your welfare programs are to assure homage and loyalty to those who give you a portion from someone else and act like it was their own. You must take from those who would oppose your ultimate goal: complete supremacy. You must seize industry before they find out the true nature of your designs. To nationalize industry, means you gain control while using taxpayer money then, enslave the people to pay back the burden thru greater taxation.
